

Brightwater Supported Independent Living

Site Information

Brightwater supports people with complex disabilities, including neurological, cognitive, psychosocial and physical disabilities.

We are an innovator in the area of acquired brain injury rehabilitation, and also provide specialist supported independent living for people with acquired brain injury Huntington's disease.

All of our homes are:

- Accessible and functional, with modifications like hoists, ramps and handles available if required.
- Close to local amenities, community services and public transport.
- Equipped with a shared computer and WiFi access.
- Supported by trained Brightwater staff, including sleepover shifts and overnight assistance.
- Close-knit and cosy housing complexes with a range of configurations.
- Shared and each client has their own room.
- If you have NDIS or private funding, we can also help you access allied health services including physiotherapy, occupational therapy, social work and more.

We have two supported independent living sites specialising in services for people living with Huntington's disease and six supported independent living sites supporting clients with acquired brain injury.

Please see below for support levels for each site:

- **Balcatta** – A cluster of three houses, each with up to four adults with brain injury who have medium to high physical support needs.
- **Bentley** – A cluster of two bedroom units for adults with brain injury who access the community independently and require mostly light supports and prompting.
- **Cannington** (Hamilton House) – A family style shared house for up to six adults with brain injury who have light physical support needs.
- **Carlisle** (Ellison House) – A cluster of three houses, each with up to four adults with Huntington's disease and have medium to high physical support needs.
- **Belmont** (Kailis House) – A duplex of 3 bedroom houses for people living with Huntington's disease and have light physical support needs.
- **Manning** – A duplex of four bedroom houses for adults with brain injury who have medium to high physical support needs.
- **Maylands** - A duplex of 3 bedroom houses for adults with brain injury who have medium to high physical support needs.
- **Warnbro** - A duplex of 6 bedroom houses for adults with brain injury who have medium to high physical support needs.

Balcatta

A community house for adults with medium support needs.

Nestled north of the river and surrounded by lush green gardens, Brightwater Balcatta is a supported community house for adults with complex disabilities.

Consisting of 3 spacious houses, Brightwater Balcatta is a comfortable place for 12 people to call home. Our housemates have medium support needs and live their lives as independently as possible, with extra support for day-to-day activities including assisted lifting with or without hoists.

Each Brightwater community house is fully equipped and accessible, close to public transport and supported by trained Brightwater team members who will encourage you to connect with your community and reach your potential.

Bentley

A community house for adults with light support needs.

Conveniently located near Curtin University and Westfield Carousel, Brightwater Bentley is a supported community for adults with complex disabilities.

Consisting of 6 self-contained 2 bedroom units, Brightwater Bentley is a friendly place for 8-10 people to call home. Our housemates require light support and live their lives as independently as possible, including independently accessing local shops, going to the gym and participating in disability employment activities.

Each Brightwater community house is fully equipped and accessible, close to public transport and supported by trained Brightwater team members who will encourage you to connect with your community and reach your potential.

Cannington

A community house for adults with light to medium support needs.

A community house for adults living with Huntington's disease


Centrally located in Belmont, Brightwater Kailis House is a supported community house for people who are living with the initial symptomatic stages of Huntington's disease.

Ellison House

Specialist care for people living with Huntington's disease

Centrally located in Carlisle, Brightwater Ellison House provides 24/7 specialist care for people living with the later stages of Huntington's disease.

Brightwater Ellison House is a comfortable place for 12 people to call home. Our residents have higher care needs, with staff available 24 hours a day who are skilled at providing support as our residents' care and mobility needs change. Our staff assist with personal care, medication management, dysphagia management, nursing and palliative care, as well as accessing therapy and medical support as needed.

Our home is fully equipped and accessible, close to public transport and supported by trained Brightwater team members who promote independence for as long as possible, with extra assistance whenever required.
